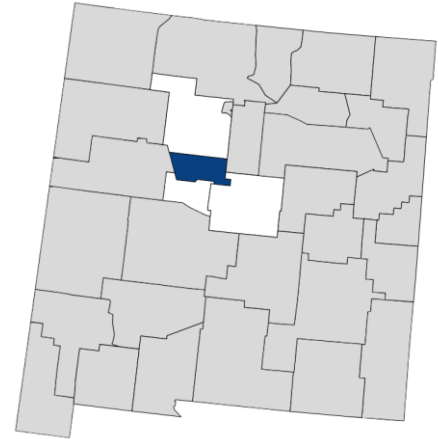


Community Overview

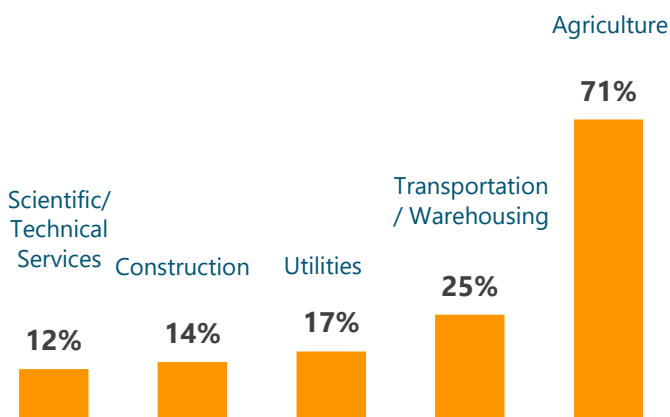
Community Overview

As of 2021 the region's population increased by 0.8% since 2016, growing by 5,497. Population is expected to increase by 0.9% between 2021 and 2026, adding 5,920.

From 2016 to 2021, jobs in the city of Albuquerque declined by 0.4% from 358,530 to 357,149. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.8% by 2.2%.

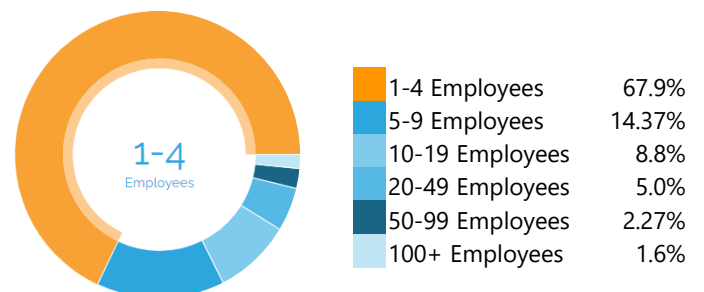

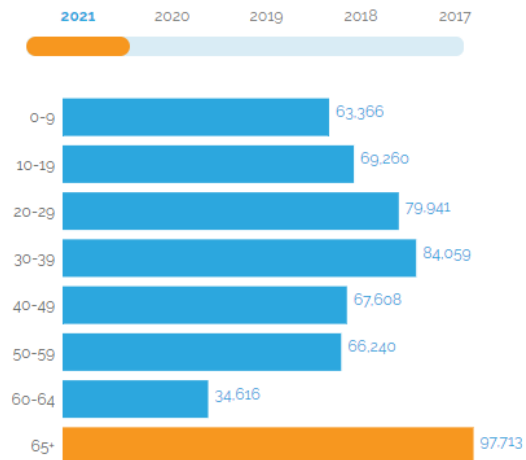
