
# **Community Overview**




### **County Overview**

As of 2021 the region's population increased by 2.1% since 2016, growing by 19,277. Population is expected to increase by 1.9% between 2021 and 2026, adding 17,789. From 2016 to 2021, jobs declined by 0.7% in Albuquerque, NM from 420,454 to 417,531. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.7% by 1.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.1% to 58.8% between 2016 and 2021.


