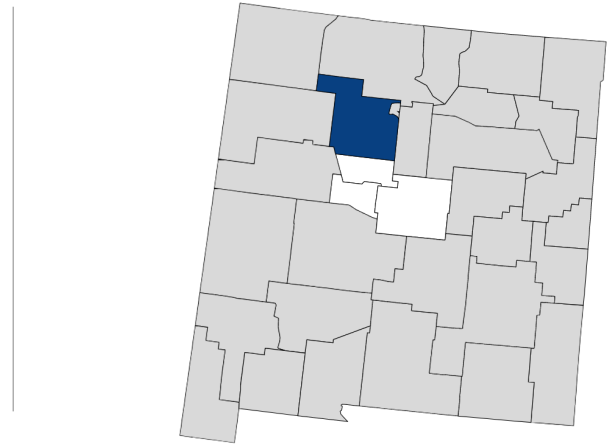


Community Overview



Sandoval County | New Mexico

Sandoval County encompasses 3,714 square miles of diverse geography and has a population of approximately 150,000 people. It includes the incorporated municipalities of Bernalillo, Cuba, Corrales, Jemez Springs, Rio Rancho and San Ysidro, as well as numerous unincorporated communities, and all or portions of seven Indian pueblos and all or portions of six Tribal entities/lands.



County Overview

As of 2021 the region's population increased by 7.2% since 2016, growing by 10,164. Population is expected to increase by 5.7% between 2021 and 2026, adding 8,543. From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 2.4% in Sandoval County, NM from 34,856 to 35,679. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 0.7% by 1.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 57.5% to 55.8% between 2016 and 2021.

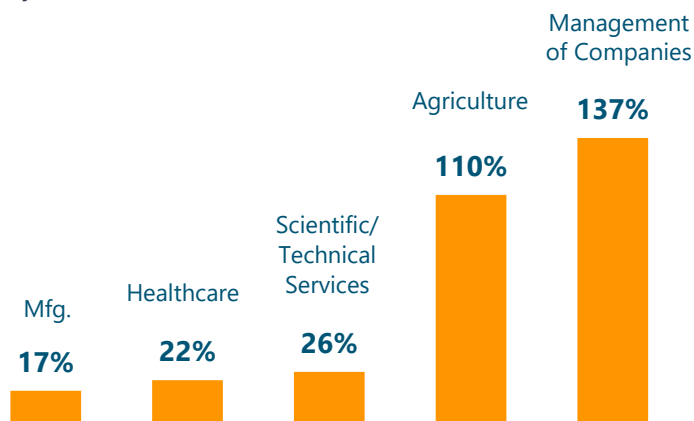

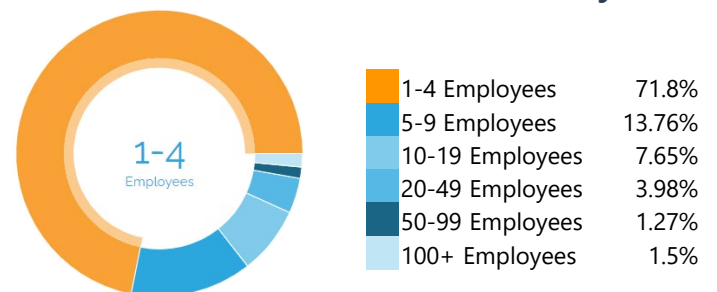

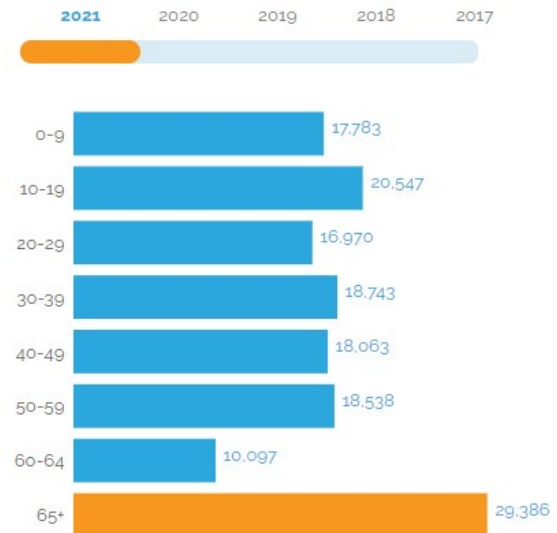
