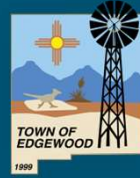
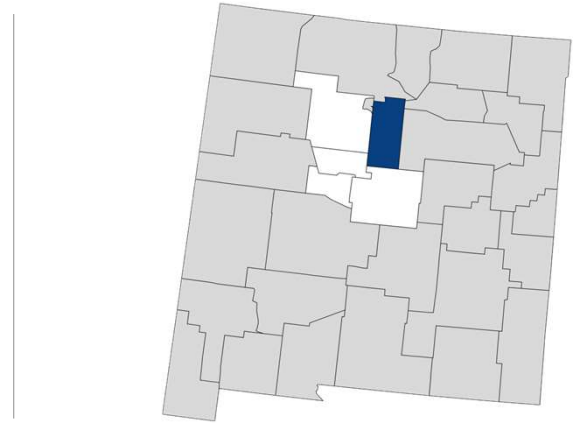


Community Overview

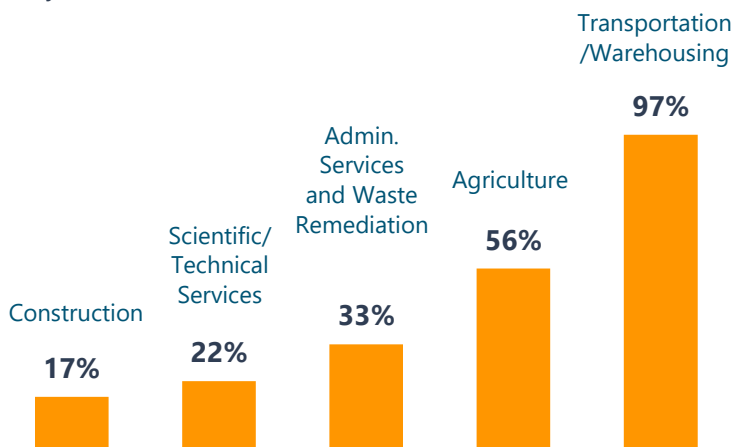
Community Overview

As of 2021 the region's population increased by 14.2% since 2016, growing by 1,169. Population is expected to increase by 5.1% between 2021 and 2026, adding 485.

From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 3.5% in Edgewood, NM from 2,945 to 3,047. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.8% by 1.7%.

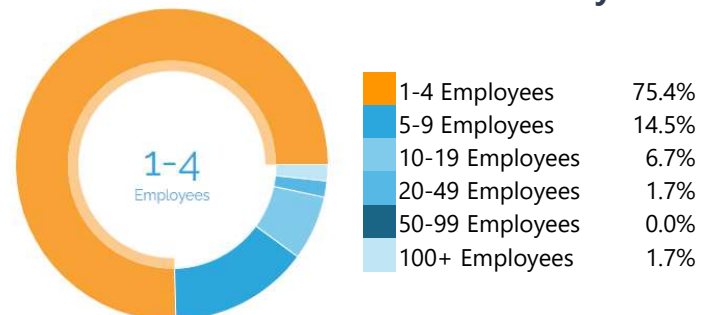

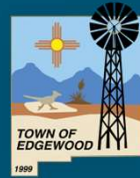

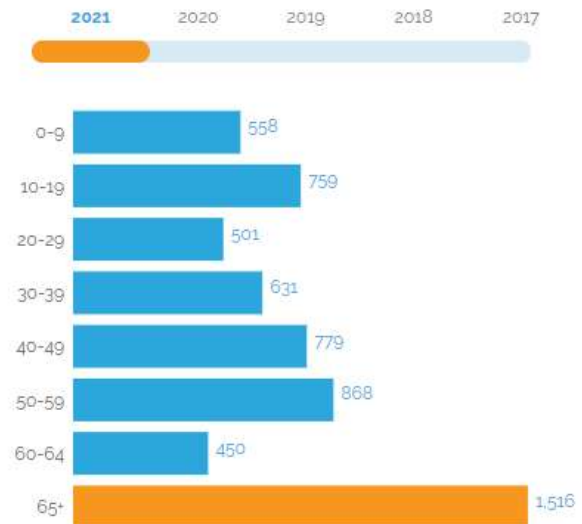
