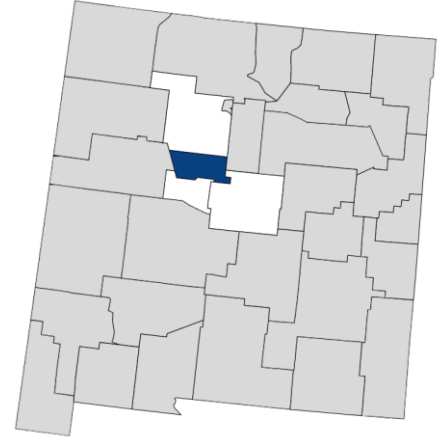


Community Overview

With more than 560,000 residents, the City of Albuquerque is the population and commercial center of the state. Albuquerque is the urban center of New Mexico and one of America's best mid-sized cities. The 32nd largest city in the country, Albuquerque's economy is emerging with strength in space technology, directed energy, smart community technologies, and film and digital media.



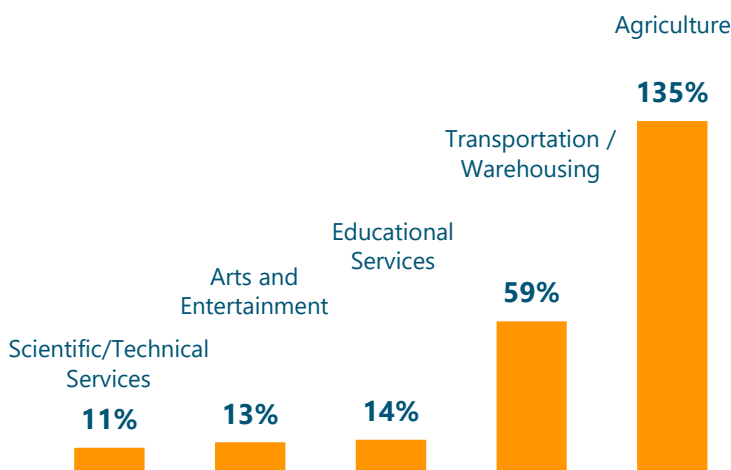
City Overview

As of 2023 the county's population declined by 1% since 2018, falling by 6,612. Population is expected to decrease by 1.5% between 2023 and 2028, losing 10,310.¹

From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 3.3% in Bernalillo County, NM from 370,119 to 382,238. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 0.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.1% to 62.4% between 2018 and September 2023.¹

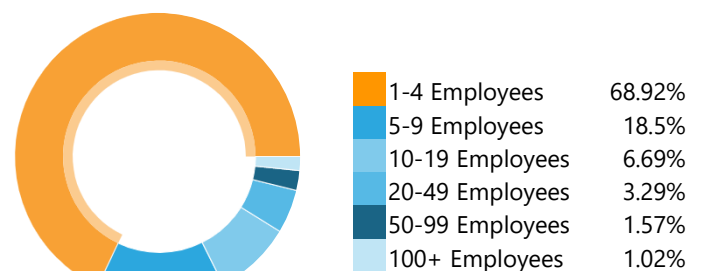

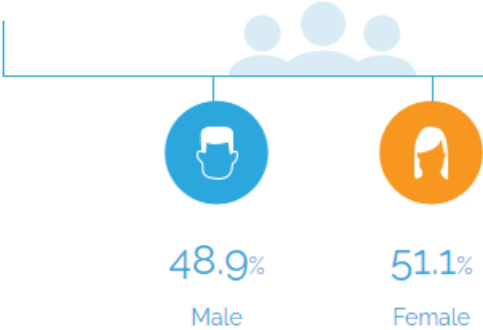

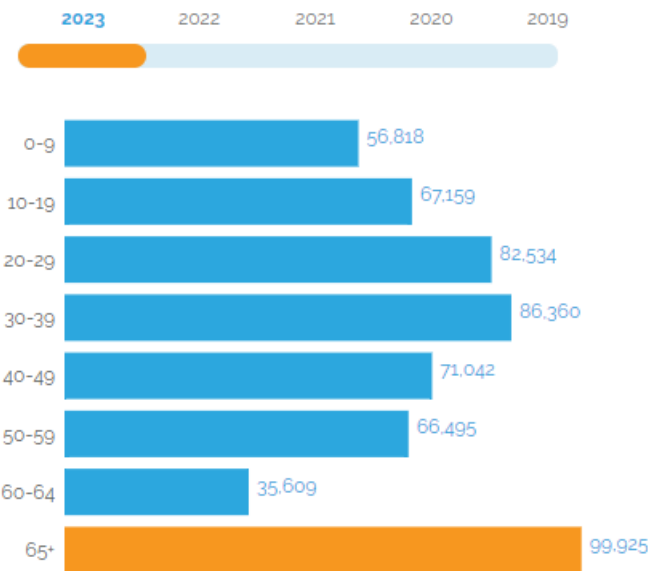
