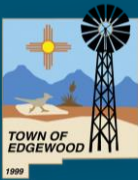
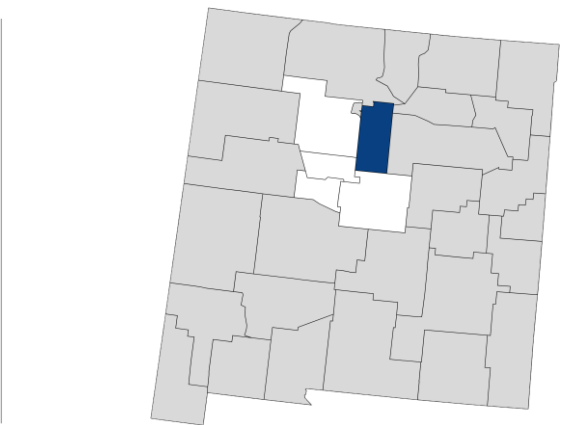


Community Overview



Town of Edgewood | New Mexico

The town of Edgewood, at the southern border of Santa Fe County, provides exceptional opportunities for quality of life in Estancia valley. Systems of trails promote hiking, cycling, skating and horseback riding and a plethora of retail businesses. Other amenities include Sandia National Wilderness, Wildlife West Nature Park, Sandia Peak Ski Area, gliding/soaring and general aviation at one of three area airports.



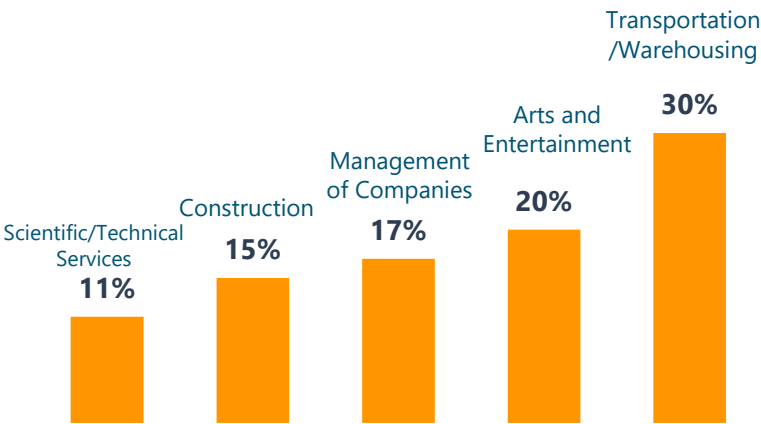
Community Overview

As of 2023 Santa Fe County’s population increased by 5.2% since 2018, growing by 7,734. Population is expected to increase by 5.4% between 2023 and 2028, adding 8,558.¹

From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 1.3% in Santa Fe County, NM from 74,506 to 73,553. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs decreased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.7% to 53.6% between 2018 and September 2023.¹

Top Growth Industries

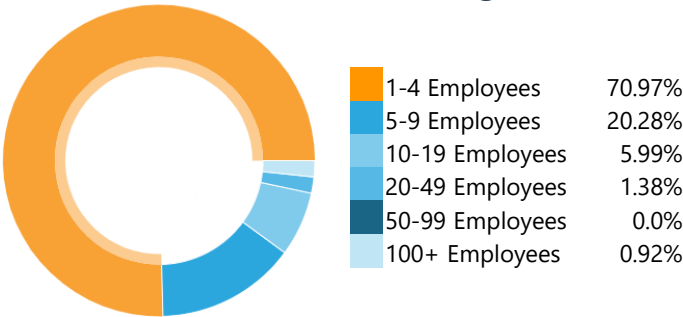
5-year Job Growth, 2018-2023¹

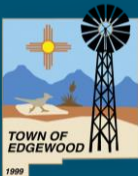

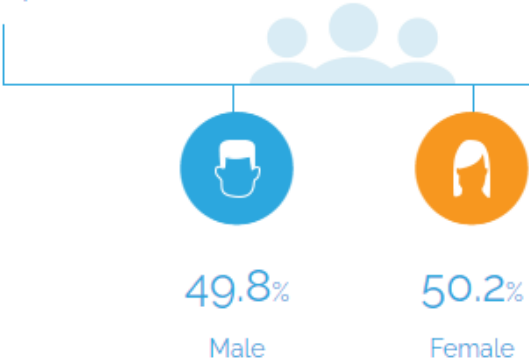

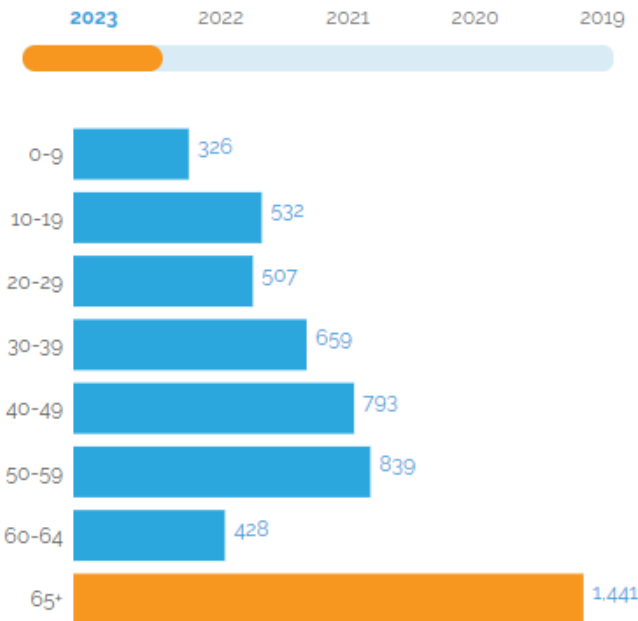
