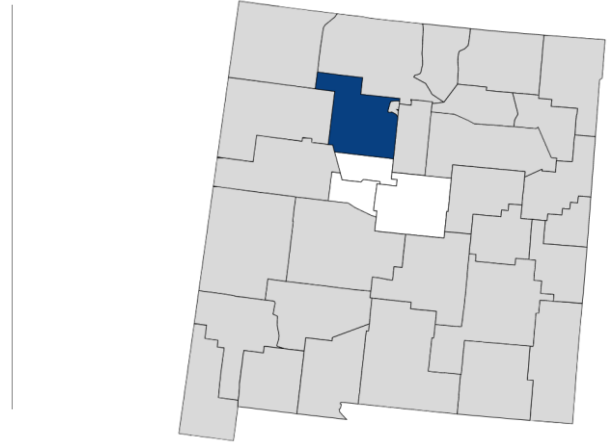


Community Overview



Sandoval County | New Mexico

Sandoval County encompasses 3,714 square miles of diverse geography and has a population of approximately 154,000 people. It includes the incorporated municipalities of Bernalillo, Cuba, Corrales, Jemez Springs, Rio Rancho, San Ysidro, and the Town of Cochiti Lake, as well as numerous unincorporated communities and all or portions of 12 Indian Pueblos and Tribal Nations.



County Overview

As of 2023 the county's population increased by 7.1% since 2018, growing by 10,301. Population is expected to increase by 6.4% between 2023 and 2028, adding 10,029.

From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 7.8% in Sandoval County, NM from 35,995 to 38,794. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 57.4% to 54.7% between 2018 and September 2023.

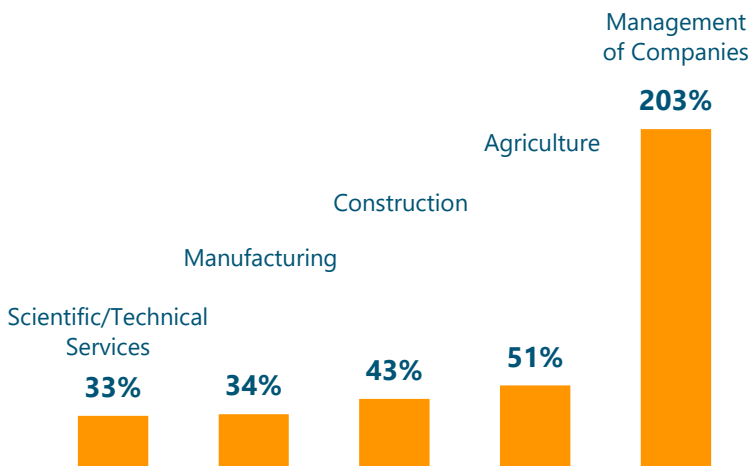

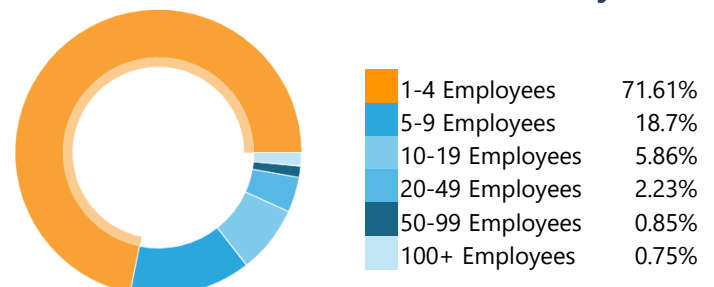

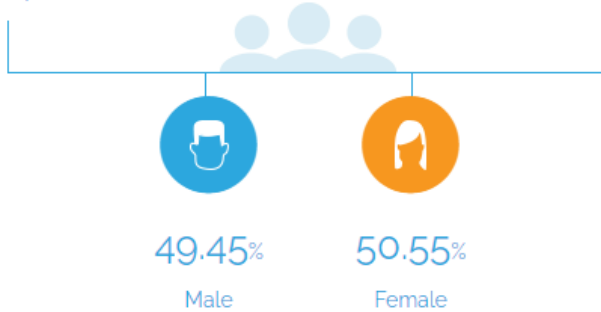

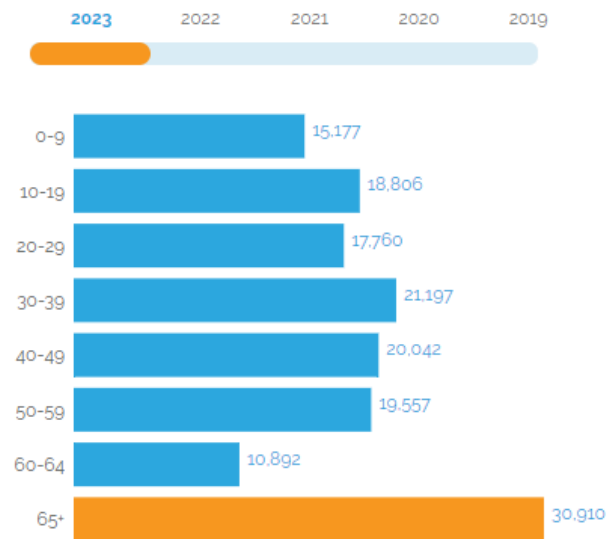
