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### IN THE NEWS: HEADLINE HIGHLIGHTS

New Mexico Delegation Promotes the State's Bioscience Industry: A delegation of government, economic development, association and industry leaders and businesses represented the New Mexico bioscience industry at the BIO International Convention in San Diego June 3-6.

Rocket Lab Allocated \$23.9 m in US HIPS Act Funding: Launch services and space systems provider Rocket Lab USA Inc has signed a non-binding preliminary memorandum of terms (PMT) with the Department of Commerce that would see Rocket Lab receive up to \$23.9m in direct funding under the CHIPS and Science Act.

The proposed investment would enable Rocket Lab to increase its production of compound semiconductors for spacecraft and satellites, as part of an expansion and modernization of its facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

AREA's focus on site readiness AREA urged local leaders to prioritize site readiness to attract high-paying jobs. They emphasized proactive site development, including infrastructure and utilities, before companies show interest. AREA proposed at least \$5 million in state investment for site readiness programs to enhance Albuquerque's competitiveness.

New Mexico and Quantum Tech Advancements: The article identifies seven U.S. cities with potential to become quantum technology hubs, including Albuquerque. These cities have strong research institutions, vibrant startup ecosystems, supportive governments, and applications for quantum technologies in industries like healthcare and finance, positioning them well for future quantum advancements.

<u>German Space Startup iBoss HQ in ABQ</u>: German startup, iBoss, is developing advanced pieces of space hardware has picked Albuquerque as the headquarters of its wholly owned U.S. subsidiary, with customer and employee growth expected in the Duke City after rolling out a new product offering.

**EDD prioritizes science and tech industries for economic development:** The New Mexico Economic Development Department (EDD) is focusing on boosting the state's economy by investing in aerospace, bioscience, intelligent manufacturing, cybersecurity, and green energy. EDD plans to allocate \$750,000 to analyze these industries, aiming to retain graduates and create

high-paying jobs with an average wage of \$90,599—substantially higher than the state average.

<u>Intel shares it's new Community Investment report:</u> Intel's Community Investment Report highlights their deep-rooted commitment to New Mexico, spanning over 40 years. They emphasize ongoing support for local nonprofits, schools, and New Mexico-based businesses, alongside investments in sustainability initiatives.

Comcast expansion in Rio Rancho: Comcast is investing \$150 million to expand its Xfinity network in Rio Rancho, aiming to connect thousands of homes and businesses by 2026. This project is part of a larger \$257 million investment in New Mexico over three years, focusing on digital infrastructure and community partnerships to support economic growth and digital inclusion.

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














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
