
Community Overview


Community Overview

As of 2023 the region's population increased by 10.1% since 2018, increasing by 713. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 390.

From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 12.0% in Belen (zip code 87002), NM from 5,493 to 6,154. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 8.4%.




