


Community Overview

As of 2024 the region's population declined by 10.7% since 2019, falling by 2,463. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 370.

From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 14.5% in Belen from 5,309 to 6,079. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 10.6%.






