
Community Overview



City of Rio Communities | New Mexico

Founded in 2013, Rio Communities is a city located along the east side of the Rio Grande River in southeastern Valencia County. Its panoramic views of the Manzano Mountains at sunrise and spectacular sunsets over the West Mesa make Rio Communities a sought-after destination for retirees and young families alike. The City is also actively establishing a robust economic development foundation to meet the growing needs of its community through economic incentives and strategic industrial zoning.



Community Overview

As of 2024 the region's population increased by 3.7% since 2019, growing by 2,831. Population is expected to increase by 4.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 3.471.

From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 13.1% from 18,222 to 20,611. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 9.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 51.2% to 51.6% between 2019 and 2024.1






