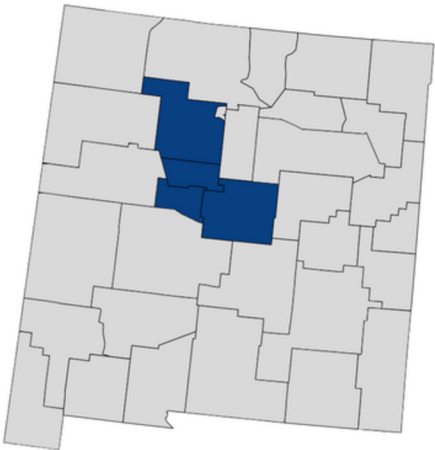

Metro Overview

As of 2024 the region's population increased by 0.4% since 2019, growing by 3,470. Population is expected to increase by 0.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 3,622.

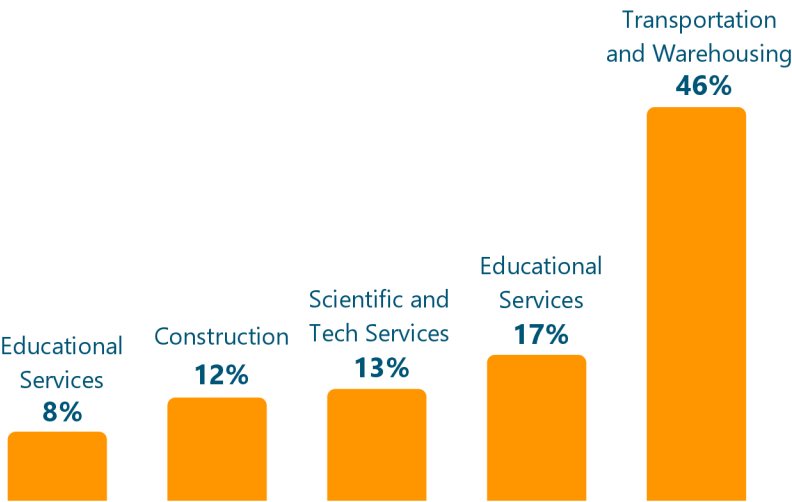
From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 3.7% from 434,923 to 451,012. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 0.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 59.2% to 61.2% between 2019 and 2024.

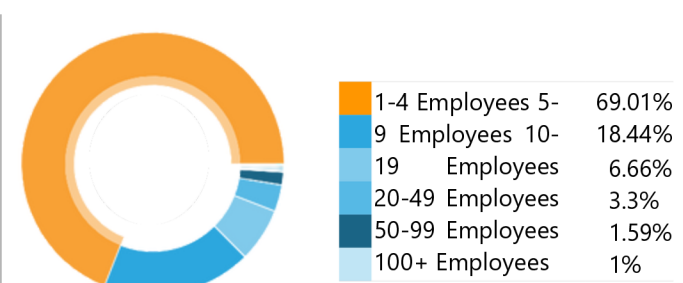

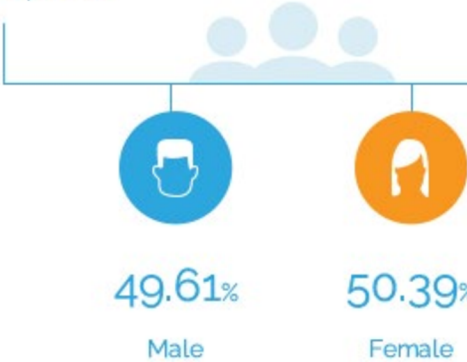

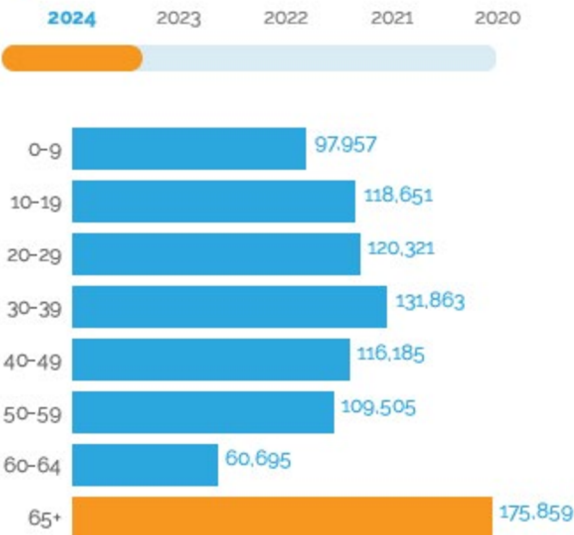
